

ESB scholarship application form

The ESB has, as part of its mission of general interest, launched a **student aid program**, with a **financial section**. The fund is supplied by a collection from businesses and the general public, subsidies received from local or national authorities and by any other means deemed compatible with the aim. The funds gathered are, among other things, intended to financially support access to ESB studies, through a scholarship.

Each student candidate at the ESB can submit a scholarship application file when registering.

This file and the information it contains are confidential. It is only established in order to evaluate the applicant's situation.

The study of the application files is carried out by a mixed independent committee composed of:

- a representative of young graduates
- a social services professional, partner with the ESB
- a professional in the sector
- a SEVE representative
- the Administrative and Financial Director
- and the head of the Fundraising

The file must be dropped off on MyESB when registering.

The scholarship is granted for a year. It can be combined with other aids (CROUS grant for example). It can be renewed (providing that the school has financial possibilities).
